Ray Young and Eldon Bauer have been called to work once again. The Lillooet Airport is located along the Fraser River, about 297 miles from Kelowna, BC, which is a four hour drive from our home base. Flying would have been much faster than driving, but lots of heavy

tools are needed, so this option is out until the major work is completed and the plane is almost ready to fly.

Having spent a few days working on the plane we will need to make the decision to fly the plane or transport it back by trailer to Oliver, B.C. In order to park the plane inside the hangar we will need to rearrange the other aircraft, putting one outside on the grass. The small



rental hangar is close to being full with the aircraft and parts. AWA Canada has been blessed with donated planes for our pilots and we are eternally grateful. We now need a much larger hangar that isn't a rental. It will take some time to get this plane airworthy and then ferry it up to its new home in Alaska. AWA can utilize it in the mission field doing work where it is needed the most. It will help low time mission pilots build hours at a more affordable cost.
