Nicaragua has been met with two hurricanes this November, Eta and Iota. Barreling over the region leaving destruction in their wakes. Severe flooding and destruction from high winds have left many without shelter as their homes were lost, roofing ripped off, and yards flooded. As the water rose in the rivers and winds whipped the waterfront, hospitals were evacuated to churches and then churches to government offices.

AWA has been in direct communication with the church family in La Tronquera along with SDA contacts in Bilwi (Puerto Cabezas). God willing we hope all are holding strong and the base and plane remains undamaged. As always, we will stay in touch to gather information on the needs and for any damage on the base that is done.

The Fix family was in the state of Florida helping with hurricane storm damage from current local storms. Josh, being a qualified contractor and owning his own business for tree service, is capable of clearing debris and cutting down broken trees. His skills are not only useful in the USA, but will be in great demand when he is deployed to the Nicaraguan Project.

The Cessna aircraft for Nicaragua is still receiving final maintenance and safety checks before it starts its long journey to the mission field. Significant finances are still needed to make this a reality.


