On October 12th the Guyana Civil Aviation Authority reopened Cheddi Jagan International Airport and the Eugene Correia International Airport to controlled scheduled international flights. Praise the Lord for answered prayers!

Although the airports opened on October 12th, Suriname Airways intends to begin operations on October 22nd, Copa Airlines on October 26th and American Airlines on November 4th. Consequently, travel to Region 1 where our project base is located is limited due to the number of coronavirus cases in the region. Thus, Monique and Bruce plan to head to Guyana at the beginning of December to visit the project, assess and reestablish airbase operations and missionary activities.

shared our plans to enter the foreign missions field. When I opened the envelope a check for \$1000 fell out with a note about how they also planned to give us \$100/month after we arrived in Guyana. My heart stopped and Glenda too was speechless. "... Before they call, I will answer: and while they are still speaking, I will hear." Isaiah 65:24

Later, as we had time to share with more of our family and friends, one church member asked me incredulously, "How are you going to survive? Do you know some wealthy people who will support you?" Thankfully our Provider had already prepared my heart to answer, "God will provide for Himself..." Genesis 22:8. Praise Jesus our faith was confirmed so quickly! I am reminded of the lesson in Luke 9:3 when He sent out the disciples and told them not to take anything for the journey, yet they lacked nothing. The gospel spread and great miracles were performed as a result of their complete surrender.

The crisis caused by Covid-19 has meant financial hardship for many, and yet the God of Miracles has continued to show us His power. Glenda is thrilled with the idea of becoming a pilot to serve in mission work, but we have never had much in savings and the cost to learn to fly is daunting. Yet, in less than 3 months we have enough saved to pay for ground school and private pilot's lessons for the first phase of licensure! Since we have been faithful in our tithes and offerings, God has always amazed us in regards to our finances. We feel like the numbers should not add up the way they do.
