However, they were closing in an hour and a half and we must complete an online application before we could head to the clinic, 20 miles away. We are not going to make it, I thought. Bruce prayed and we drove home, completed the application online and began driving to Passport Health. We arrived on time thank God, but we were told no guarantee that we receive the results within 24 hours.
