



## ***Remote Village Covid Mitigation Initiative***

Among Alaska's 225 native villages, in spite of state and federal infrastructure upgrades, many are still without public water and sewer systems. You can imagine the challenges of trying to follow public health measures and recommended hygiene practices in this context.

An effort to help these villages has been initiated by a state-wide PPE Resource Taskforce. Partial funding by the Rasmuson Foundation of Anchorage with supplemental funding from the Cares Act has carried this effort forward. The other agencies or entities

involved include, Lynden International, providing Freight Services to each distribution point; Alaska Medical Missions has covered the procurement and logistical planning for appropriate quantities to be supplied for each household in each of the target locations.

ACS (Adventist Community Services) is providing warehouse space in Fairbanks for secure storage until the shipments can be distributed to the villages. And lastly AWA-Alaska will be completing final distribution to 11 villages in the Interior. This will require between 25 and 30 flight hours over the span of two weeks or more.





A portion of our operating expenses will be covered by available funding from the sources noted above.

We feel honored to be asked to provide this important service in this time of great need. We encourage our supporters to pray for the safety for our pilots for these mid-winter flights during the limited daylight. Also, please consider what financial resources you might direct our way for these humanitarian efforts.

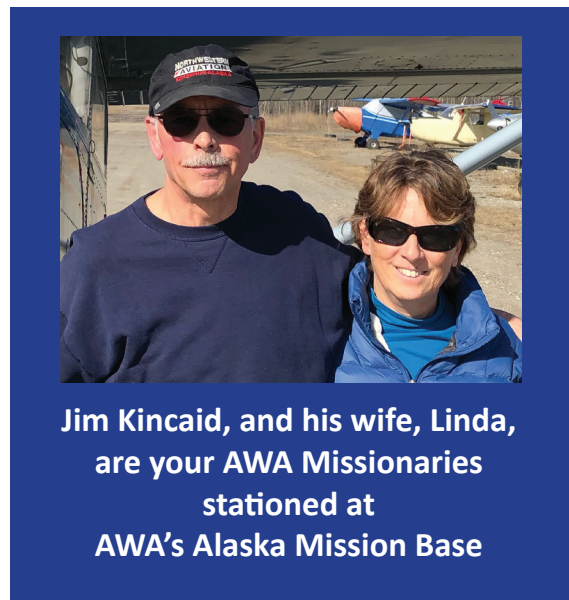
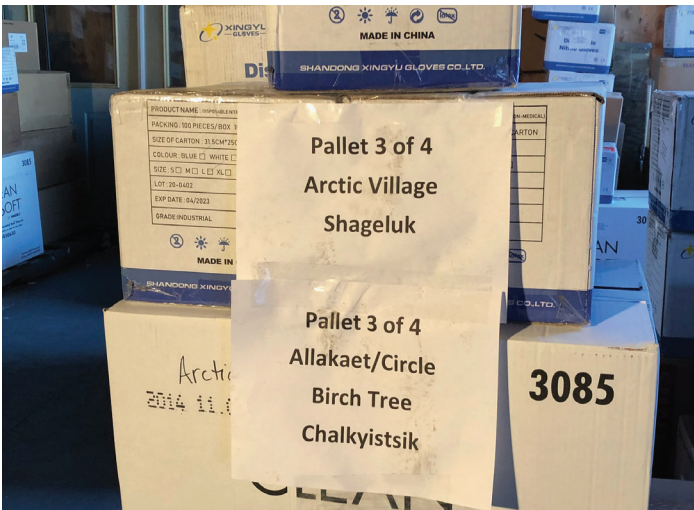
The people are experiencing difficulties never before seen here. AWA is here to help and thanks to your prayers and support we will continue to serve wherever possible.
