

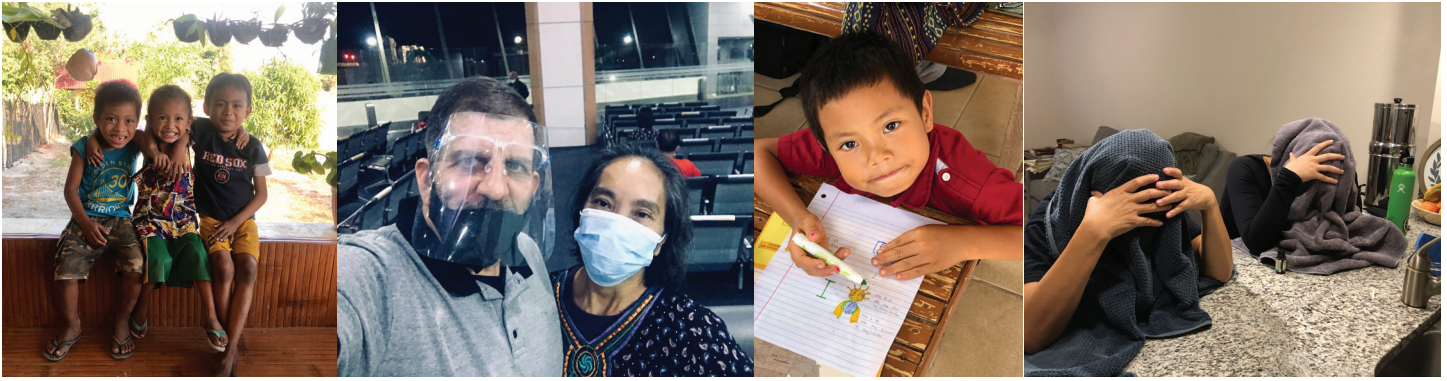


2021 Begins With —

Not so good news... according to Health Alerts for the U.S. Citizens in the Philippines, there is a ban on entry of travelers from the United States. Starting Sunday, January 3, 2021 at 12:01 a.m., the Philippines temporarily banned the entry of travelers from, or who have transited through, the United States. Passengers coming from the United States or who have transited through the United States who arrived before Sunday should have been allowed to enter the Philippines, but would have been required to complete a 14-day facility-based quarantine regardless of their RT-PCR test result.

The Philippine government has also suspended all flights from the United Kingdom and barred entry to travelers originating or transiting from the following locations: The United Kingdom, South Africa, Switzerland, Italy, Denmark, Israel, Hong Kong, Spain, Ireland, the Netherlands, Singapore, Lebanon, Japan, Canada, Germany, Sweden, Australia, France, Iceland, and South Korea.





Thus, our return to the Philippines is temporarily on hold. We miss the children the most, as well as the beautiful beaches. In all of this, God has a plan for each of our lives and He has a plan for our Philippine Project in Palawan. Our plan is to return to the Palawan Project in the month of May, but we are watching and waiting for His plans. Please continue to support us and this ministry that God has blessed through all these years.
