Both planes were to be deployed back to Smithfield, NC for further maintenance at AWA's head office and maintenance hangar.

Bruce and Monique Wilkerson joined us for a week, as they are currently in the USA. They agreed to fly the Cessna 172 to Smithfield. The first leg of their journey was to Albuquerque, New Mexico, but to bad weather there and tornadoes ahead of them, they were grounded in Chickasha, OK for a few days.

With one plane on its way, Ray and Kyle continued to work long hours on the 206; sweltering in 100 degree



temperatures with no shade! They dealt with multiple issues, installed several crucial parts, and after two weeks the plane was finally cleared to fly.

At last, on June 2nd, at 7:05 a.m, with our navigation and GPS heading set to the direction of North Carolina; Kyle, Ray and I set off in the 206. The performance of this "old bird" was sensational, and the view as we flew over Scottsdale, New Mexico (Route 66), and Amarillo, Texas was stunning!

After three days of *17 plus hours of flying* we touched down in Smithfield just before sunset on Friday. We were all very grateful!
