

In the 16 years I lived and worked in the Northwest Arctic I was daily surrounded with the evidence of God's care and His appreciation of beauty, which overflows even in the high latitudes. Though we are now living thousands of years down the line since God's Creation, one can still see and appreciate what God has done.

I remember the day when the accompanying photo was taken. I had flown some government surveyors in our floatplane about 100 miles up the Kobuk River from Kotzebue, which is where my base was at the time. The surveyors work would consume several hours during which I would standby. It was a warm day with temperatures in the 70s Fahrenheit. My typical activities during such standby charters would be to read a book, take a nap, or, after being sure that the airplane was secured to the riverbank, I might take a little hike, watching closely for grizzly bears.

On this particular day, I was overwhelmed with the beauty. It was as "perfect" a day as humans get to experience. The reflection on the mirror finishes of the river made me visualize the "sea of glass"—a feature of the New Jerusalem—which will soon be a reality for those who are found in Christ.
