3-To become a naturalized citizen of Nicaragua. Because my mother is originally Nicaraguan, though she is now a citizen of the United States, I can claim citizenship. This will open many possibilities to our work that would otherwise make logistics very complicated.

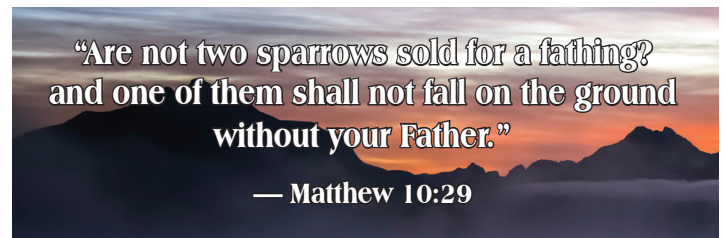
4-Re-home our furry and feathery friends: seven cats, one big dog, and two chickens. Marley, our dog, was our
