Thus, even though her heart desires to go to school and learn, she decided to halt attendance until restrictions are relaxed. Please join us as we lift up Annely in prayer for courageous faith. This reminds me of the story of Daniel and his three friends who refused to partake of the king's wine and food found in Daniel 1:3-20.

Subsequently, thank you to all our donors who have provided books at various times and reading levels. Annely is using her time wisely by reading, reading, and more reading!

On September 24th, a landmark in Mabaruma, the secondary school was destroyed. Around ten o'clock at night, the historic school building caught fire and burned to the ground. Most of its current and previous students, including Annely, mourned this tremendous loss to the community. Unfortunately, memories are all that remain.

As a result of this tragedy, students will resume classes online until a new facility is built. This unusual event means that Annely can now continue her formal education online and graduate with her class when the time comes. What an unexpected blessing that resulted from her courageous faith. Indeed, we serve a wondrous God!

Annely has a slight obstacle. The government will provide internet service but she needs a computer to participate in her online classes. We are prayerfully asking for any support towards our goal of raising \$750 for Annely to purchase a computer. Your prayers and financial support will enable Annely to finish her secondary school education and to find a good job that will help her family.
