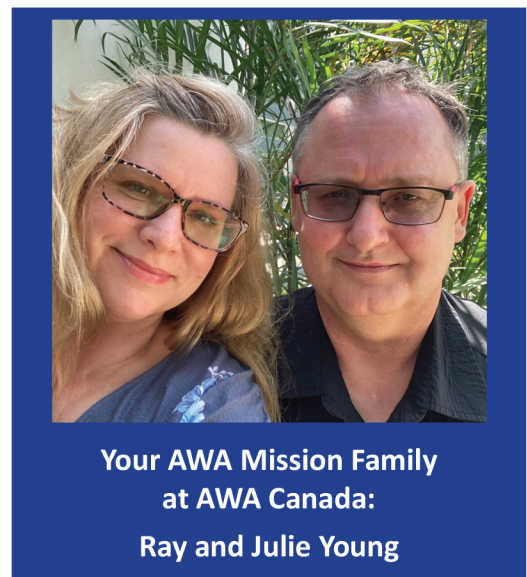
PRAYER REQUEST:
