

The weather and the availability of Glenda's little Cessna 150 are the limiting factors for her to finish her requirements, and then it usually takes 2 weeks get on the schedule for the licensing exam.

We were really hoping to be on our way to Nicaragua before the end of March, but God has His own plans that we are seeing unfold before our eyes. We have met another missionary named Jason Raney who is an electrician and he is making plans to come help us build a community center and a church for the Miskito



people. Read more about that story in the AWA Airways magazine this quarter. We have also begun to develop a relationship with the ministry FARM STEW founded by Joy Kauffman. It is an amazing ministry with a "recipe" to help poor, malnourished communities to grow their own nutritious food, learn the Bible's health message, and create a source of income to better their lives. We are expecting to see miracles through the partnership of AWA and FARM STEW. These developments are only happening as a result of the delay in our plans. Praise God for having all things under His control!

I have two questions for you and us now: Do you know when Jesus is coming to take us home? Are you excited? I'm sure your answer is no and yes. No, we don't know exactly when He is coming, but the task of fulfilling prophesy is nearing its completion. And yes, we are excited. I absolute love Luke 21:28 which has the message for us at for this very time, "Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift your heads, because your redemption draws near." I pray we will all keep a tight grip on the hand of our Savior, because
