Then on March 9, 2022, I received a panicky call while at the Sagpangan mission house. My mother was in agony and taken to the hospital for a uterine infection. While there, doctors found she had high blood pressure, decreased platelet count and heart complications at the same time her blood sugar kept spiking. Several times she lost consciousness apparently due to the excruciating pain she was facing.

The whole family was in the hospital everyday praying and encouraging each other especially our parents; inay at itay.

A few days later our mother began fainting and her life seemed to be slipping away. She began developing fluid in her lungs. As her children we continued to provide her the strength to fight for life. We prayed together and continued to ask the Lord for strength and endurance.





Gradually we were able to talk to our mother but at the same time sad when the doctor explained her many ailments to include sepsis, type 2 mellitus uncontrolled complicated UTI and infection diarrhea secondary to amoeba. We did not sleep all night to sincerely pray and call on the Lord. We asked our mother to wake up again and to have the ability to speak. Although each of us were not ready, we fully trusted in the Lord.

In the almost three weeks our mother was in critical condition we continued our petitions to the Lord, and He sent people generous in helping us financially in purchasing needed medications as well as those who donated blood to prolong our mother's life. Prayers and trust in the Lord have continued to be our strength and endurance in the trials of our lives. On March 29th, she was discharged from the hospital. Praise the Lord!
