For approximately three weeks, five of AWA's finest men flew from various parts of the world to get a jump start on the Guyana project. Kyle and Jeff from North Carolina, Bruce from Illinois, Pastor Deyvid from Brazil and Cesar from Nicaragua all came together to the project in Mabaruma, Guyana. After two years of inactivity due to the Covid pandemic, there were many obstacles to tackle.

The first order of business was water. Water was none available at the living quarters due to an inoperable pump, so Kyle pulled up his sleeves and together with Bruce got the water going. Next were the planes. Kyle stayed on course and went to work. During the first week, N8838X was running and purring like a kitten.

The 5-men team met with government officials to re-establish connections. They visited church leaders and the various communities of Hobo Hill, Barabina,

Khan's Hill, Township and Kumaka. They adopted a stray dog, gave it a bath, called him Buddy and made him their mascot. They conducted outreach



to various communities from the generous donation of a dear Sister from England. They distributed tracts and literature. Cesar even carried injured Brother Stoll to church. Pastor Deyvid and Cesar even conducted inventories of all assets from the storage areas, barns, and storerooms in addition to thoroughly cleaning the respective areas.



As of the writing of this newsletter, they are still there with many plans: for Pastor Deyvid to conduct a year-long awaited communion, more outreach, securing the boat and planes and painting the Center.

Cesar is planning to return with his family within a few months. Pastor Deyvid plans to return as soon as he completes all his necessary flight instruction.
