



AWA PHILIPPINES WAS AT MOUNTAIN VIEW COLLEGE

Adventist World Aviation Foundation Philippines Inc (AWA) attended the Southern Asia Pacific Division (SSD) wide Sabbath School/Personal Ministries, Children Ministries, NDR/IEL on June 9th -15th of 2024.

Mountain View College is an Adventist Educational Institution under the SSD territory, located in Valencia City, Bukidnon. This institution was established by the early pioneers who saw in a vision a place on top of the mountain as a good place and is now the place where the Educational Institution was established. MVC has a land

area of 1,000 hectares, including waterfalls that serve as their source of electric power through a hydropower plant.

MVC was the venue of the SSD-wide SS/PM/NDR-IEL congress, where about 50,000 plus Adventist Leaders and members came to attend from countries in Asia and the Philippines.

AWA was allowed to put up an information booth to let the church members know of this kind of ministry that we do in the province of Palawan. The 5x5 meter space was free of charge.

AWA. Sometimes, they would ask us about the Yellow Bee, the small chopper that was lost in the west Philippine Sea while doing a medical evacuation. By putting up an AWA information booth, we are now perceived as a reliable and safe means of air logistic support for the Filipino people, especially in the MIMAROPA region (Mindoro, Marinduque, Romblon, and Palawan). We brought goodies (Hopia) from Palawan and let attendees have a free taste of this delicacy. We distributed brochures and calling cards and solicited their prayers for this ministry, as we are told in the Bible that more prayers, more power.

On the third day of the congress, there was a family who shared their talent and used half of our booth where they could sing and display their USB with songs. Many people took pictures with

our logo in the background, helping us promote our ministry. We have distributed about a hundred brochures, praying that the church members will somehow support us through their prayers and hopefully even financially.

Overall, the congress was successful, and all the attendees were inspired and refreshed with learning and inspiration that they had heard during devotionals and topic presentations. We also provided an AWA t-shirt for the singer.
