New Hope in Central America: Lay Pastor Audicio Begins Evangelistic Mission with Adventist World Aviation

Adventist World Aviation (AWA) base in Central America has once again become a hub of mission activity and gospel outreach. At the heart of this revival is lay pastor Audicio, a dedicated and passionate servant of Christ who, along with his family, relocated to the AWA base at the end of June to begin a new chapter of evangelistic ministry.

"This is not just a job—it's a calling," said Pastor Audicio. "We are here because people need to know that Jesus loves them, that He died for them, and that He's coming back soon."
