## RIVER MINISTRY UPDATE – MISSION BOAT RESTORATION PROGRESS

**Dear friends and partners of AWA, grace and peace!**

We have many reasons to praise God! His hand is evident in every step we take, guiding us, opening doors, and renewing our strength. Today, we are excited to share something very special with you: we've begun restoring the mission boat to restart the River Ministry, a vital tool that will carry God's love to people who live far from everything but never beyond the reach of His grace.

The region of Mabaruma, where we serve, is surrounded by winding rivers and scattered communities deep in the jungle, inaccessible by road. For dozens of Indigenous and river-based communities, the only way to receive help—or hear

the Gospel—is by boat. This boat is not just a means of transportation; it is a vessel of hope, capable of bringing Bible studies, spiritual encouragement, prayer, medical assistance, and the comfort of Christ to those who need it most.

We still need a few essential items before the boat can sail again:

1. A fuel filter
2. A fuel pump
3. A battery
4. A trailer tire
