



UPDATE FROM MANILA

Believe it or not, we have only one month left before welcoming another new year, 2025. Since the beginning of my admission with the AWA Palawan base as a new team member, I have been working on my training flights with Capt. Jed on the 182 and on the ground with basic water survival skills training during the day and night. It was a good experience and preparation for future challenges.

Due to a recent storm in central Luzon and around Manila, the weather has changed a lot here, but no extremely severe storms like the ones in the last few months. Since I am in Manila, I have been working on

renewing my Commercial Pilot License, recurrence flight, and the road towards getting my 182 rating. I collected my two overdue ACR cards at two different locations (SM North immigration office and Quezon City Hall immigration students desk office). Later, I traveled from Quezon City to the Pasay Manila school's main office to pick up my temporary license from the Flite Line School student officer. I also sorted out my paperwork for my possible flight schedules to fly on the following week, 19th-20th and 21st of November 2024, if only the weather permits. After finalizing everything, I took the Victory Liner bus from the Pasay bus station

around 3 p.m. I arrived home at Olongapo City around 7:30 p.m. due to traffic and weather conditions. But all in all, I praised God! I was able to get things done and going now.

Here is the list of things I finished;

- immigration visa extended for another two months
- Student Study Permit
- immigration ACR
- CPL temporary License (Collected) to allow me to fly
- School flight schedule set for 5hrs flight time.

Thank you for all the prayers and support. It wouldn't be possible without it. I will soon get my temporary license at the Manila Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines and start flying as quickly as possible to renew my license with Flite Line Aviation.
