



LIGHTING THE DARKNESS ALONG THE RÍO: A CALL TO PLACE GOD'S WORD IN MISKITO HANDS

Deep in the heart of Central America, along the winding waters of the rivers, live the Miskito people—an indigenous community spread across villages where roads do not reach, and where access to education, health, and the gospel remains limited. Adventist World Aviation missionaries have entered these isolated regions with medicine, food, and spiritual encouragement. Yet, one request keeps rising above all others: *“Please, can you bring us Bibles in our own language?”*

The Miskito people have preserved their culture, traditions, and oral stories for generations. But for many, the story of Jesus Christ—the hope of the cross, the assurance of forgiveness, and the promise of eternal life—has yet to be fully understood in their own heart language. Some have heard fragments of the gospel in Spanish, but the depth of God’s Word comes alive most powerfully when read in one’s mother tongue. That is why the need for Miskito Bibles is so urgent.

A Door God Has Opened

The Biblical Society has recently made available a limited supply of **1,400 Miskito Bibles**, priced at only **\$6 each**. These Bibles are a treasure for evangelism and discipleship. Imagine the joy of a grandmother holding her very first Bible and being able to read it to her grandchildren by lamplight. Imagine a young man in a riverside village, previously caught in despair, encountering the words of Psalm 23 for the very first time in his native tongue.

Our missionaries know firsthand that no gift we can bring is greater than the Word of God. Food sustains for a day. Medicine heals for a time. But Scripture transforms lives for eternity. These Bibles will be placed directly in the hands of those who have never owned one, in communities where Adventist World Aviation pilots and partners are actively working to reach the unreached.

The Cost—and the Opportunity

At \$6 each, the shipment of 1,400 Bibles represents an investment of **\$8,400**. This may sound like a large number, but broken down, it is incredibly achievable:

- \$30 provides 5 Bibles for 5 households.
- \$60 places 10 Bibles in the hands of seekers.
- \$120 equips an entire small village with Scripture.
- \$600 sponsors 100 Bibles, fueling revival across multiple communities.

Every gift, large or small, will directly place the Word of God in the hands of a Miskito believer or seeker.


The Miskito people are waiting. Their hearts are ready. God has opened this door for His Word to flood into places long in spiritual darkness. Will you help us walk through it?
