Greetings from Mabaruma, Guyana! We want to share an exciting and very special update from the mission field. By God's grace, we have officially begun a new season of Children's Evangelism here in Region One.

Evangelism for Children Has Started

Mabaruma is filled with children — many of them growing up with little access to consistent Bible teaching. We believe this is one of the most critical moments to reach them, because their minds are still new, open, and ready to receive the Gospel.

Every week, we are teaching them about:

- The love of Jesus
- Bible stories and prophecy
- Prayer and faith
- God's purpose for their lives

We are seeing their faces light up as they learn that Jesus knows them and cares for them.

A Need for a Better Place

As the number of children continues to grow, we urgently need to provide them with a more appropriate and dedicated environment.

To continue this evangelistic work effectively, we are praying for support to secure:

- An exclusive room for children's meetings
- A laptop for lessons and Bible presentations
- A projector for visual evangelism and Bible stories

The estimated budget for this children's evangelism project is:

\$9,000 USD

This investment will help us build a space where young hearts can be shaped for eternity.

Urgent Mission Transportation Need

In addition, we are currently facing a serious challenge with our mission truck, which is essential for:

- Transporting supplies
- Visiting communities
- Supporting evangelistic outreach

At the moment, the truck is broken and requires:

- A new battery
- A steering rod replacement
- Mechanical labor and repairs

The quotation for these repairs is:

\$3,000 USD

Without this vehicle, many areas would become extremely difficult to reach.
