On December 31st, 2025, Pastor Tenywa was admitted to the hospital. At around midday, pastor Tenywa could not talk. He had a severe headache, then he lost speech and memory. That very day, he was rushed to the hospital, where several tests and scans were carried out. He was visited by a vibrant team of youth from the Seattle church. This granted him not only comfort but also more hope that the Lord is working through evangelism among youth to reach out to fellow youth and the community at large. Five days later, he began to recover his speech slowly; his memory is also returning to normal. However, we are still going back to the hospital for medication.

We thank God that Pastor Tenywa's life is no longer in danger. Also, great thanks go to the AWA community, Pr. Batista and his wife Mariella.

It has been a month of national elections at different levels, from the presidential post to the village

chairperson. It involved chaos in other parts of the country, and some people lost their lives. We still require prayers for peace to prevail post-elections, which are still underway at the lower levels.

We still call for funding to support the setting up of a youth centre of influence for the Seattle church. Your support and prayers fuel the ministry. Thank you for believing in our mission.
