prayer, and fellowship. These gatherings have been a blessing, strengthening faith and creating new opportunities to share the gospel with neighbors and friends.

However, we are facing an important challenge. Many of the families we are trying to reach live along the rivers, in remote communities accessible

only by boat. Our mission boat currently needs repairs, and without it, it becomes very difficult for us to visit these riverside families, conduct Bible studies, and provide spiritual support.

This boat is essential for the mission here. With it, we can reach villages, encourage believers, and bring the message of hope to people who live far from the city.
