TERMITES GIVE A COMMITTEE BETTER DIRECTIONS

The church board considered constructing a Seattle Center of Influence made of treated timber. This was to kick-start the agreement between Bugema University and Adventist World Aviation; it would be cheaper and take a short time. Church members and students mobilized basic resources to begin the project while they wait for additional funding support.

The summer holiday came, and students went to their different countries. Unfortunately, during the holiday, the timber was eaten by termites. We were forced to transition from timber to blocks and cement.

Now that the University has resumed, they are returning to study. Still, they need a place of

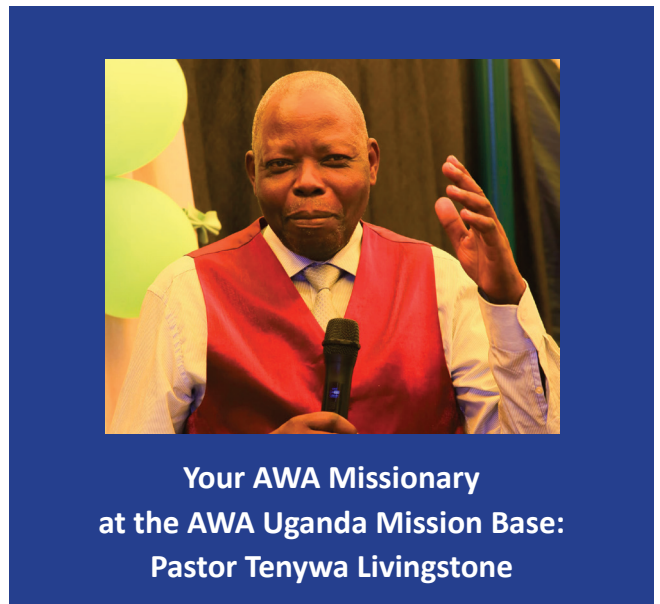
worship since the number of worshippers has grown beyond 150. Students are busy leveling the place for the church hall and the AWA office.

Therefore, it requires a total of \$8,000 to proceed with the plan to build the Center of Influence and the AWA office. The construction plan has two Phases: from ground work to foundation level, the cost will be \$3,500. From foundation level to completion of the Youth Center of Influence, it will require \$4,500.
