



## *The Gospel in the Heart Language of the Miskito People*

For many years, entire communities along Nicaragua's Caribbean coast lived without ever holding a Bible in their own language. Many families had heard about Jesus, but they could not fully understand the message because the Scriptures were not available in Miskito. Today, that is changing.

Through the ministry of Adventist World Aviation, missionaries and local church leaders are helping carry the gospel to villages that are difficult to reach by road. One of the greatest blessings we have witnessed is the distribution of Miskito Bibles. Thousands of men,

women, and children have already received God's Word in their own heart language.

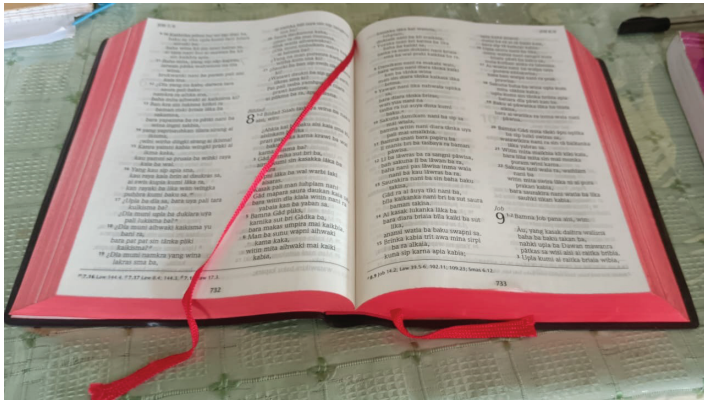
I will never forget seeing tears in the eyes of elderly people as they opened a Bible they could finally read for themselves. Mothers gather their children in the evenings to read Bible stories together. Young people are learning about Jesus and joining Pathfinder clubs, where they are growing in faith, learning discipline, and discovering that God has a purpose for their lives.

But the work is far from finished. There are still thousands more waiting for a Bible. Many remote villages remain unreached, and every mission trip

reveals more families asking for Scriptures. The need does not stop, and neither can we.

Each Miskito Bible costs only \$6. What may seem small to many can completely change a life and a family forever.

- \$20 provides about 3 Bibles
- \$100 provides about 16 Bibles
- \$300 provides about 50 Bibles
- \$600 provides about 100 Bibles



Every gift helps missionaries continue traveling to remote communities and placing the Word of God into waiting hands. Your support is not just about printing pages — it is about bringing hope, faith, and the message of salvation to people who have waited for generations to hear God speak in their own language.
