Greetings from Mabaruma!

I am Arnold Samuels, the new missionary worker for AWA Wings for Humanity in Guyana. It is great and exciting to be here because this is something I have always dreamt of doing for God.

I am so grateful for your prayers and support. Because of you, mission work is possible in Mabaruma, and we are reaching families who have waited a long time to hear the Gospel.

### HIGHLIGHTS – APRIL/MAY 2026

(1) **Cleaning and Repainting:** We cleaned and repainted the Missionary Building and weeded the yard. The place is now ready to receive visitors and serve the community.

### (2). Airplane

**Review:**

Missionary brothers Jim and Kris visited and did a mechanical review of the AWA airplanes in Mabaruma. Their help was a great encouragement.

### (3). Truck

**Inspection:** I

also had a mechanical review done on the mission truck to find out exactly what repairs are needed.



(4). **Community Outreach:** We went to Khans Hill, Mabaruma Settlement, and Tobago to do Bible studies, prayers, and encourage families to serve God. Seeing people open their homes to hear the Word was a blessing.

## CHALLENGES: TRANSPORTATION NEEDS

We have a truck, a boat, and an engine that need repair.

### (1) Truck repairs: Estimated cost USD \$5,000

If this is done, access will be easier for communities without good roads. The Gospel will also reach the riverine communities, such as Aruka, Black Water, Hobodeia, and Hoteaqui, once the motor and boat are repaired.

### (2) Boat and engine repair GYD \$200,000 =USD \$1,000

### (3) SPECIAL NEED: MISSION BUS – GYD \$4 MILLION = USD \$20,000

**Why we need it:** Right now, many villagers in Mabaruma and the surrounding settlements cannot reach church, school, or medical help because transport is too far or too expensive. Pensioners, school children, and visitors often walk for hours or miss out entirely.

#### What the bus will do:

1. Transport pensioners to clinics and pension pay days.
2. Carry school children to classes and exams.
3. Bring church visitors and outreach teams to Khans Hill, Tobago, Mabaruma Settlement, and beyond.
4. Help us move supplies for outreach and health fairs.

This is a big goal, but with God's help and your support, it is possible. Even if you can give toward one seat, one tire, or one part, you will be part of opening the road for the Gospel.

## UPCOMING – MAY/JUNE 2026

(1) **Repairs on the Porch:** The porch of the Missionary Building will be repaired. This building will host any missionary personnel visiting Mabaruma.

(2) **Health Fair:** At the mission house, people can have oral checkups, blood pressure and sugar testing, deworming, and basic health care.

(3) **Continuous Visitation:** We will keep visiting Tobago, Mabaruma Settlement, and Khans Hill for Bible study, prayer, and encouragement.

## WAYS YOU CAN PARTNER

1. **Pray:** For safe travel, strength, and open hearts in the villages.
2. **Give:** Toward truck/boat repairs, the bus fund, and outreach costs.
3. **Share:** Tell others about the work God is doing in Mabaruma.

Meeting people is important because they cannot travel long distances due to poor roads. Your partnership helps us go to them.
