GERMINATING BLESSING

On April 22nd, we received support from AWA for the construction of the Bugema University Center of Influence, which was a joy for all stakeholders. We had planned to raise the hall within a month, but the conflict between the US and Iran escalated, and rising fuel costs increased the cost of living. This called for meetings to adjust the plan because builders were asking for much more money, and material costs had increased. Eventually, we began the excavation.

At one of the building committee meetings, it

was analyzed that the adjusted building would only accommodate current Sabbath School members. Yet, the student population is increasing, and even the community would join because of the new building's hall.

So, the challenge was to choose between a hall based on the amount we have and one that considers the accommodation needs of near-future believers and converts. The Center of Influence Building Committee voted to increase the structure's size. Currently, the excavated foundation is for a hall seating 400 to 500, an

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AWA office, and space for several community-engaging activities.

Regarding permission to build a runway, we are awaiting a response from the military chief. Then, the Civil Aviation Authority will come and give the remaining parameters and guidelines for construction.

This month, the AWA Uganda Project pauses to express heartfelt appreciation to all our partners, donors, and well-wishers. Your partnership is not just funding a building — it's building lives. We thank God for you and pray that He multiplies back to you every seed you have sown.
