



Feet that Walk, Obedient to the Call

“How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who proclaims peace, who brings glad tidings of good things, who proclaims salvation, who says to Zion, ‘Your God reigns!’” Isaiah 52:7 (NKJV)

There is something profoundly beautiful in the image the prophet leaves us: feet walking over mountains, carrying a message of peace and salvation. Not perfect feet, nor easy paths, but feet that walk, obedient to the call. And that is exactly the kind of journey that marked our past few weeks.

We thank each of you from the heart for walking with us through prayers, support, and offerings. You are a vital part of this journey, and it is through each person's commitment that this work continues to move forward, mountain after mountain, community after community.
